It is time to start planning your fall wardrobe, and this year, more than ever, everyone's number one concern is budget. We all want to know how we can look our best without breaking the bank.

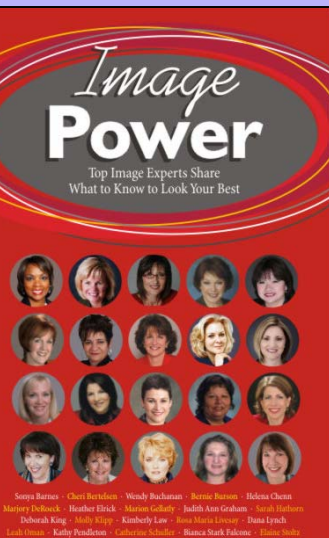
